Banana



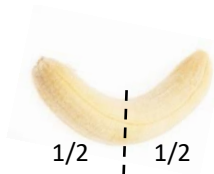
Chopped Pineapple

Pour in a glass.

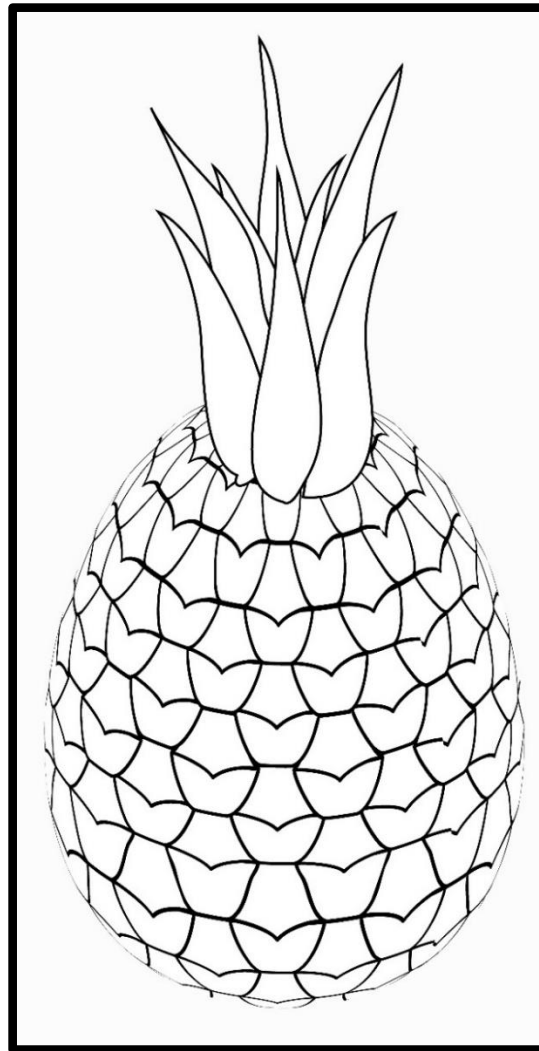
