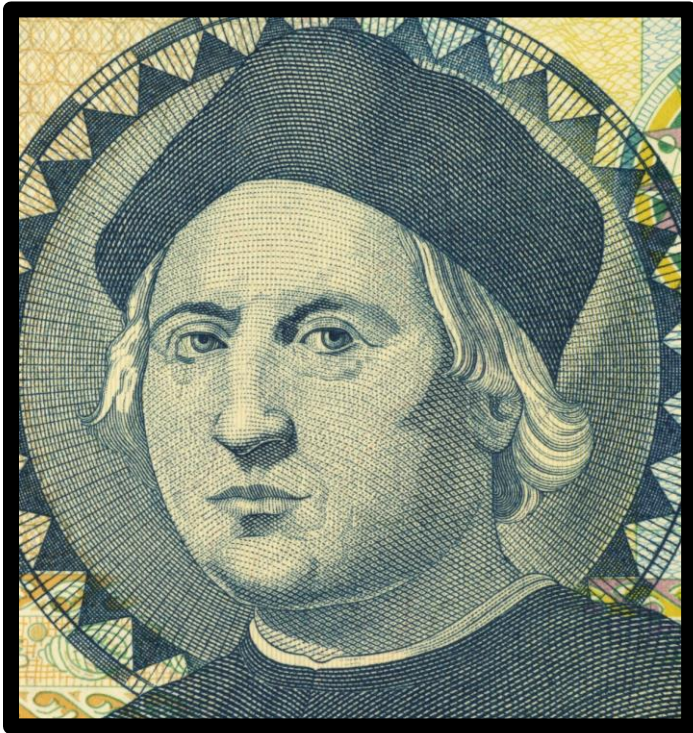
Christopher Columbus

Columbus had an idea. He wanted to try a new route to the East Indies. Columbus needed **money** to pay for the voyage.



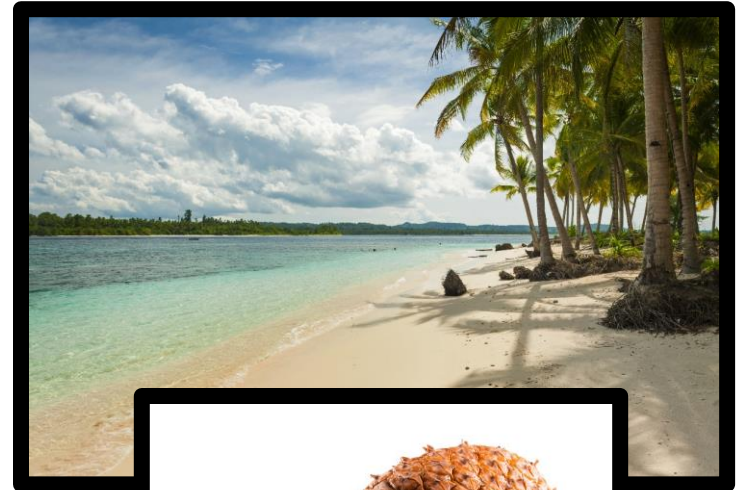
Columbus asked kings and queens to pay for the voyage. They all said "No"! Finally, the **King and Queen** of Spain said YES!

Columbus had 90 crew members. They sailed for about 60 days. They got nervous. They wanted to go home. Finally, they saw land! They were happy!

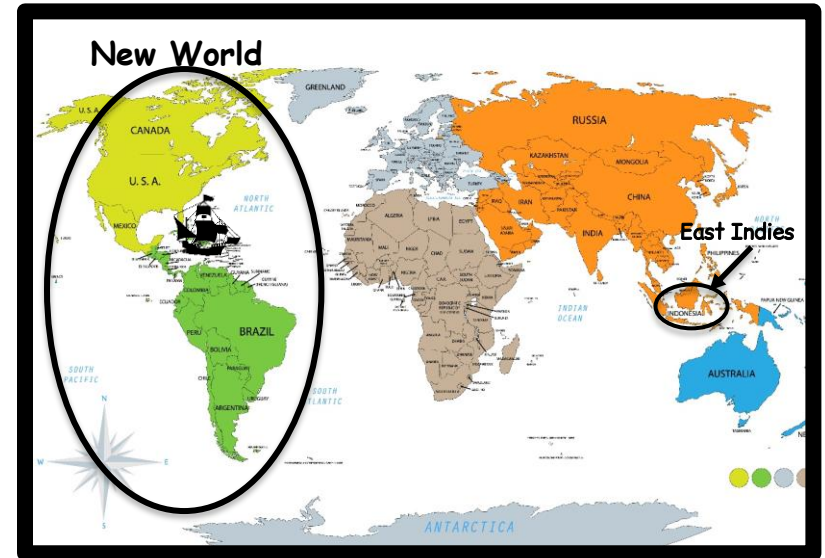


Pineapples were a new fruit that Columbus found in the Bahamas.
