Christopher Columbus was born in Italy about 600 years ago. He was an <u>explorer</u>. He wanted to find a better <u>route</u> to the East Indies.






Back then, people in Europe wanted **tea and spices** from the East Indies.

Columbus was given 3 **ships** for the <u>voyage</u>. The ships were the Nina, the Pinta, and the Santa Maria.






Pineapples were a new fruit that Columbus found in the Bahamas.

Columbus had 90 <u>crew members</u>. They sailed for about 60 days. They got nervous. They wanted to go home. Finally, they saw land! They were happy!


Columbus was excited. He found several beautiful islands. The islands are now called the **Bahamas**.


