



World War I (WWI) was a big war. It started in 1914.







Central Powers: Germany, Austria-Hungary, Bulgaria, Turkey



The other side was the **Central Powers**. They also had soldiers from many countries.




World War I started when the **Archduke of Austria-Hungary** was murdered.




Woodrow Wilson was the president of the United States during WWI. At first the U.S. was not in the war.
