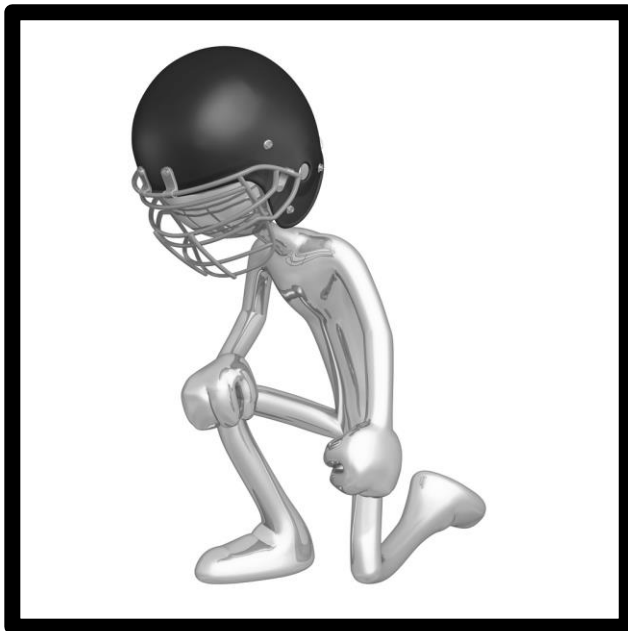

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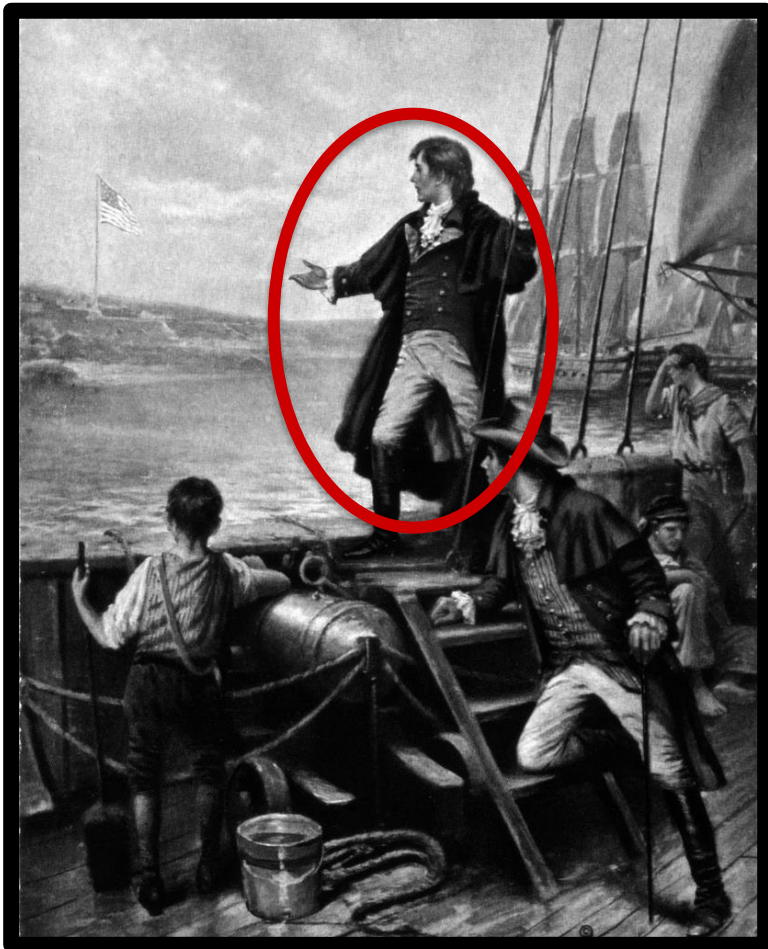


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The Star- Spangled Banner is a song. It is the National anthem for the United States.

The Star-Spangled Banner is played before important events. It shows respect for the United States.

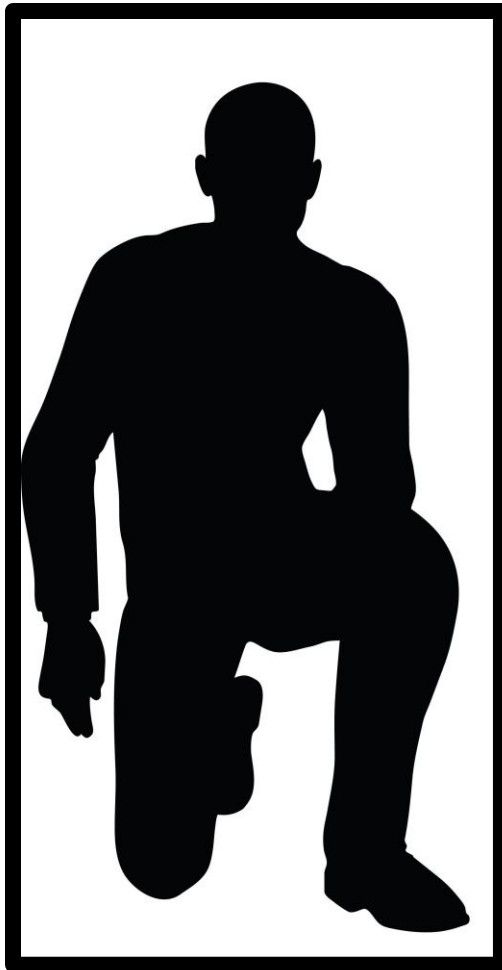


When the Star-Spangled Banner is played, people stand up. They face the flag. They put their right hand over their heart. Some people sing along.



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The Star-Spangled Banner is always played before NFL football games. The players face the flag. They put their hand over their heart.



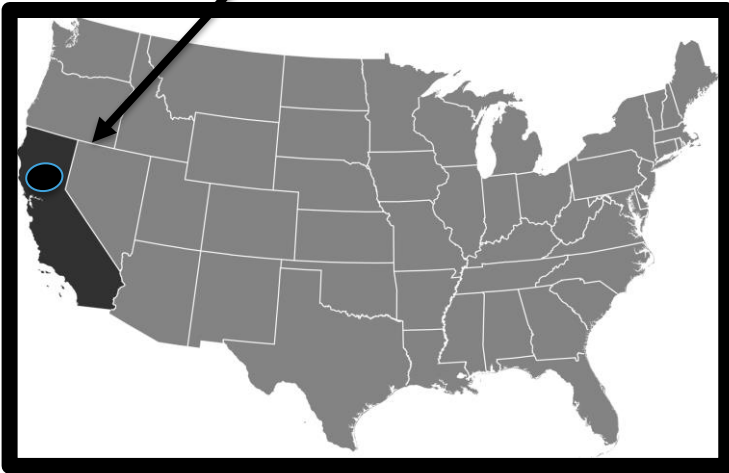
When people go down on their knee, and do not stand during the anthem, that is called "taking a knee".

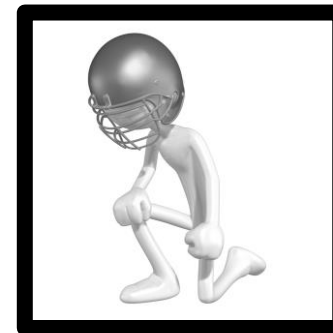


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An NFL player named Colin Kaepernick played for the San Francisco 49ers. He "took a knee" because he was upset about racism.
