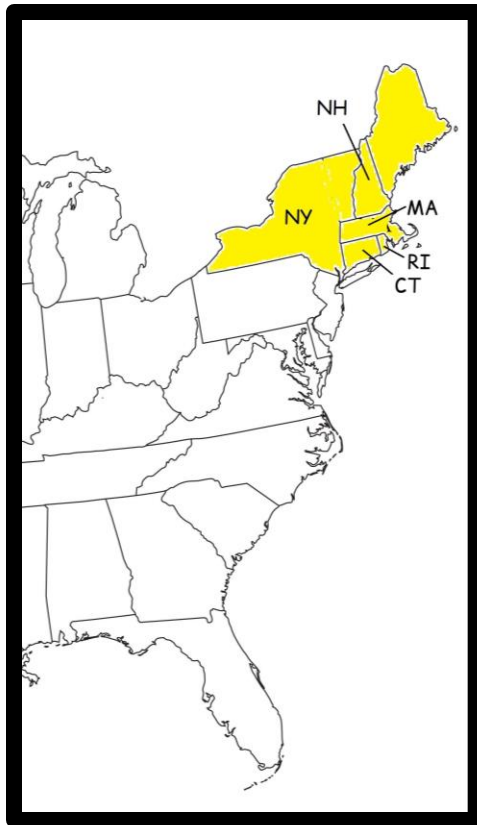

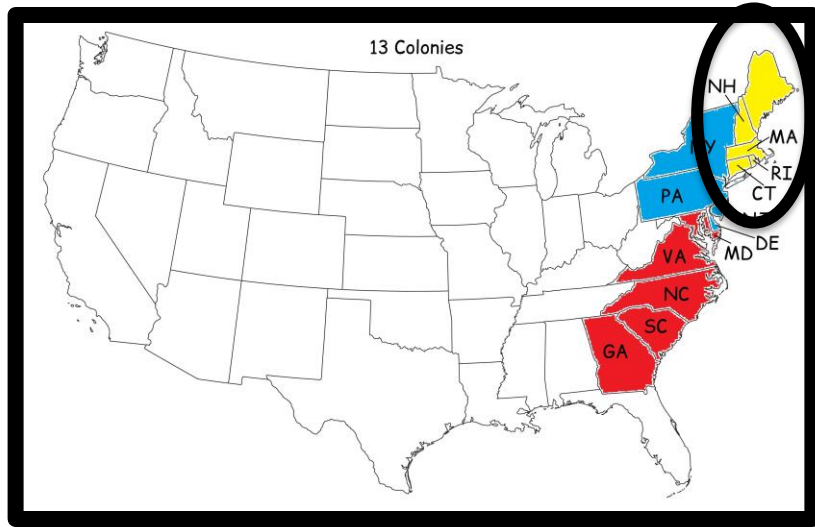
## New England Region
