

The **Grand Canyon** is a massive canyon. It is made of red rock.




Havasupai Medicine Man


Native Americans have lived in the Grand Canyon for hundreds of years. The Havasupai and Hualapai still live there today.



Spanish explorers were the first Europeans to see the Grand Canyon. They were amazed at how beautiful it was.




The Colorado River is at the bottom of the Grand Canyon. Some people go rafting on the **Colorado River**.
