

Teacher's Notes Hair Salon

Page 1: Nick's mom made an appointment to get her hair done when Nick was a young boy. When she went to that appointment, she took Nick with her. He was bored and so he started to sing. Someone thought he was a good singer and got him an agent so that he could be in musicals. Have you ever been to a hair salon. What are some things that people might do if they are waiting for someone to get their hair done? (get them to picture waiting-reading a magazine, playing with their phone, listening to music with earphones, etc.)

Take your **hair salon** Main Idea card and find a partner to ask questions and quiz each other about what we know about Nick Jonas getting discovered at the hair salon.

Page 2: When you go to a salon the hairstylist has you sit in the chair. What does he/she ask usually? If you were in a salon right now, what would you say you want done with your hair? When you go to the salon they want to know what you want done with your hair. It's good to look at pictures so that you know. (**Activity:** project Google images and search hair styles for boys then girls, etc. Facilitate a conversation as you look at each hair style. Model saying things that show you are considering wanting that hair style, etc. Note: This is a self-determination opportunity to help students see they can pick out how they want their hair cut by looking at photos.

Take your **hair stylist** Main Idea card and find a partner to ask questions and quiz each other about what we know about talking to a hair stylist about a haircut we want.

Page 3: The hair stylist washes the client's hair. It is washed with shampoo and rinsed. Why do we wash our hair? Then, we put conditioner on it. That makes our hair comb out easier. What shampoo do you use? What scents do you like? **Activity:** Bring in a variety of shampoos and smell them and talk about which ones they like, etc. Talk about how nice your hair smells when it is clean, etc. Lead a discussion on hair care.

Take your **washes** Main Idea card and find a partner to ask questions and quiz each other about what we know about taking care of our hair and keeping it clean.

Page 4: After the hair stylist washes your hair, they comb it. When you go to the salon you are the client. Are you a client if you go to a salon? Yes you are! The stylist starts coming your hair at the bottom so you don't have problems with your hair getting pulled. Model combing hair from the bottom. Activity: Have some clean brushes and let students brush each other's hair if the students want to do this. Some will not like having their hair brushed, so don't push it.

Take you're **combs** Main Idea card and find a partner to ask questions and quiz each other about what combing hair.

Page 5: Hairstylists go to school to learn how to cut people's hair so that it looks nice. Some people like short haircuts. Do you? Let's look at some short hair cuts: (google image search short hair styles) Talk about the different cuts, color of people's hair=black, brown, blond, redhead, etc. Ask students about their hair color. For example, "Do you see anyone in this room who has blond hair?" Etc. Talk about a 'ginger' being someone with red hair. Ask the class what color a particular student's hair is, etc.

Take your **haircut** Main Idea card and find a partner to ask questions and quiz each other about short haircuts.

Page 6: Not everyone likes short hair. Some people like long hair. Do you know anyone with long hair? Let's look around the room. Does anyone here have long hair. Does anyone have curly hair? Let's look for curly hairstyles on Google (similar discussion, but focused on curls and anything else you want to talk about).

Take your **long hair** Main Idea card and find a partner to ask questions and quiz each other about what they know about long hair and curls.

Page 7: Hair stylists can also color hair. Some people get their hair colored because it is turning gray and they want it to be the color it used to be. You can get your hair colored black, brown, red or blond. Do you know anyone who gets their hair colored? Do you want to get your hair colored? What color would you like?

Take your **color** Main Idea card and find a partner to ask questions and quiz each other about coloring your hair.

Page 8: Some people like to get their hair colored crazy colors! They are unusual. That means that not too many people do that. It's unusual if most people don't do it. Yes, pink hair!! Oh my. What about blue hair??? Do you like the pictures of hair colored like this? Have you seen anyone with these colors? (**Activity:** google image search for pink hair or other colors-lead discussion about it.)

Take your **unusual colors** Main Idea card and find a partner to ask questions and quiz each other about unusual hair colors.

Page 9: Do you like to go to the salon? Remind the class that Nick was discovered at a hair salon when he was waiting for his mom to get her hair done. (Review all that they know about a salon.)

Take your **fun** Main Idea card and find a partner to ask questions and quiz each other about how fun it is to go to a salon.
