## Hummingbird Nectar Recipe

Hummingbirds are small. Their beaks are small and pointed. They use their beaks to get nectar from flowers. They also get nectar from hummingbird feeders. Did you know you can make food for a feeder?

Ingredients: sugar and water

#### Directions:

- 1. Boil 1 cup of water in a pan.
- 2. Put  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup of sugar in the water
- 3. Stir the water and sugar until it disolves.
- 4. Let it cool, and put it in your hummingbird feeder.


