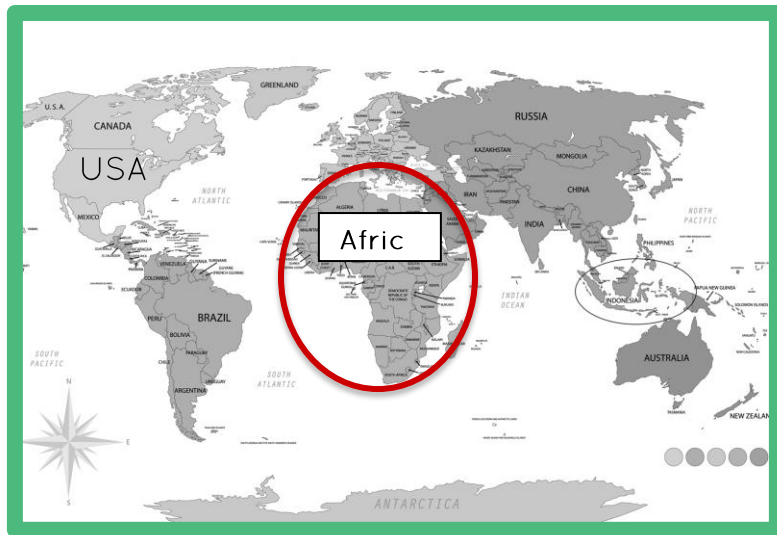
## Tropical Savanna Biome



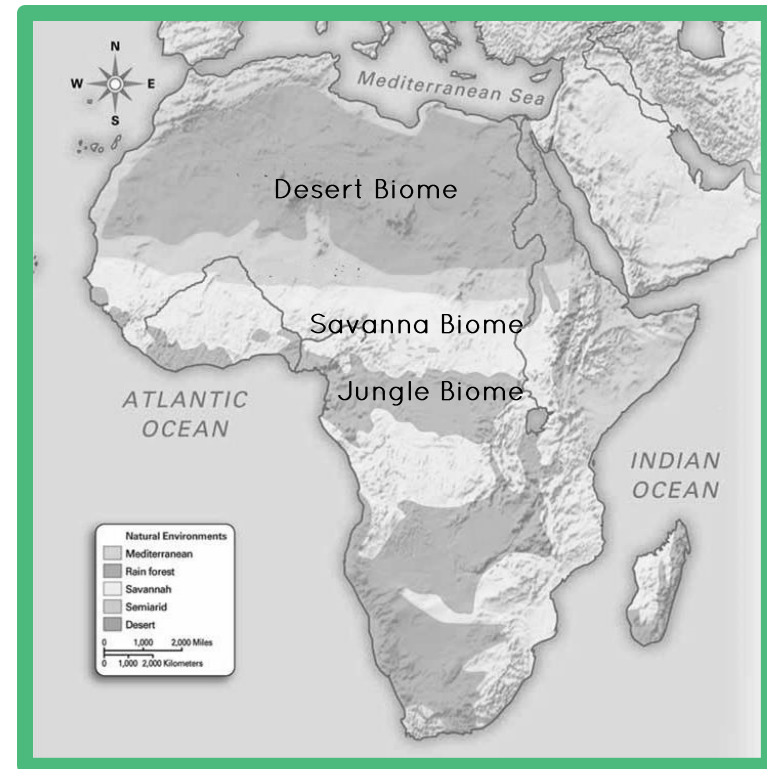

There is a tropical savanna biome in **Africa**. A biome is a place where certain plants and animals live.

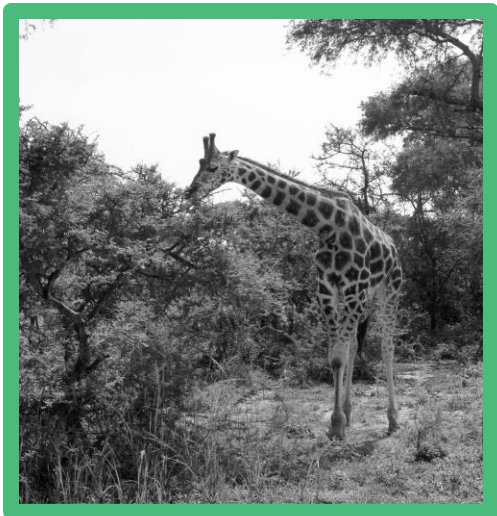


The **savanna biome** in Africa is the land between the jungle and desert.



A savanna is a **grassland**. A lot of grass grows there. There are some trees, but not very many.

There is a **rainy season** in the savanna. It rains every day for about 4 months. People, plants, and animals need water.



The rain makes the savanna very green. Some animals **graze**. They eat grass. Giraffes are tall. They eat leaves on trees.



Some animals in the savanna **hunt**. They eat the animals that eat grass.



There is also a **dry season**. There is almost no rain for about 7 months. The grass and leaves get very dry.



Dry plants can catch on **fire**. Sometimes lightning strikes the dry grass. That can start a fire.



The **weather** is usually warm. Sometimes it is cold at night. Many plants and animals live in the savanna biome. The savanna is their home.
