
**Martin Luther King Jr. (MLK)** had a dream. He wanted people with black skin to be treated in a fair way.




Back then, there were rules to **separate** black people and white people. MLK wanted to change those rules.




One rule was separate **schools**.

MLK did not like that.




Martin Luther King Jr. gave
