




The Native American Indians were the first people to live in the United States.




Native Americans live on the Turtle Mountain Reservation. It is in North Dakota.




A reservation is land owned by Native American Indians.

Not having an address caused a problem for the Native Americans.






There is a new law in North Dakota. People need an ID with an address to vote.
