

Original Thirteen Colonies




The colonists lived in the 13 colonies.


Great Britain

The <u>colonists</u> did not want a king!



It was called the **American Revolution**.






The British soldiers were called **Redcoats**.






The soldiers from the colonies were called **Minutemen**. The soldiers got ready in a minute.
