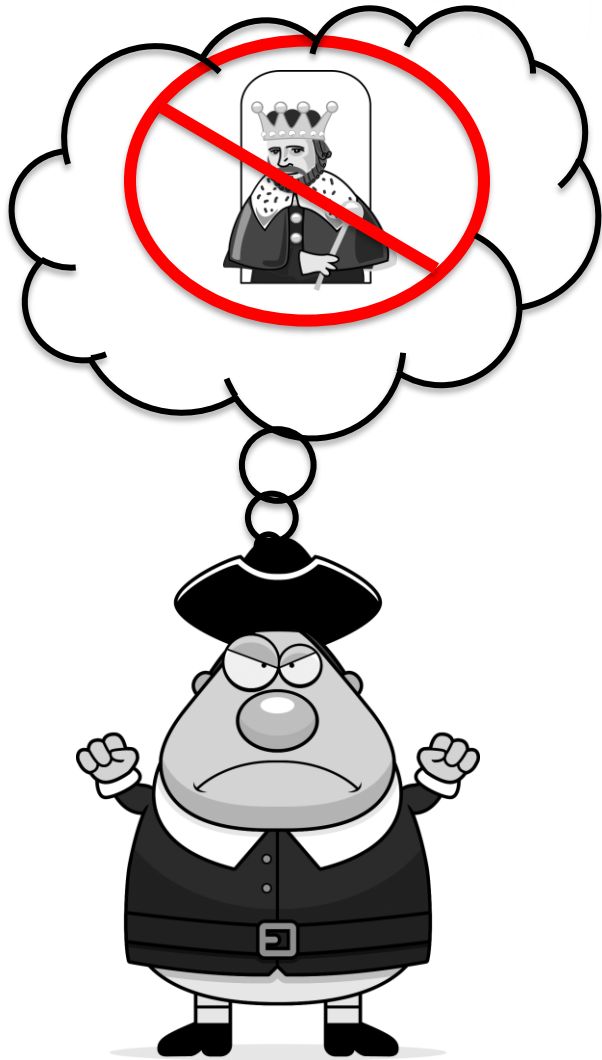
Great Britain

King George III owned the 13 colonies. The King lived in Great Britain.



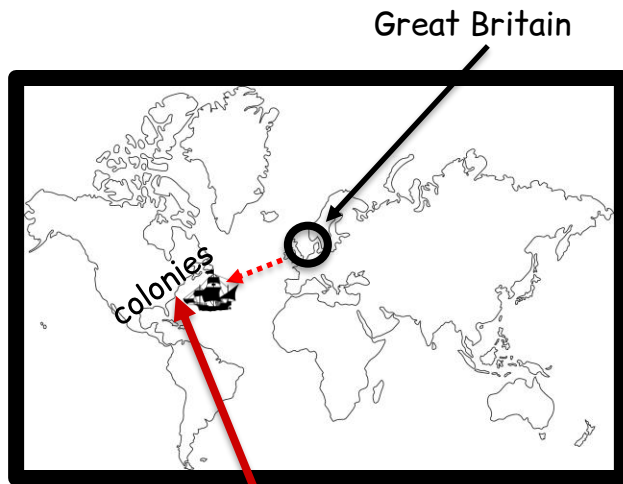
The colonists did not want a king!

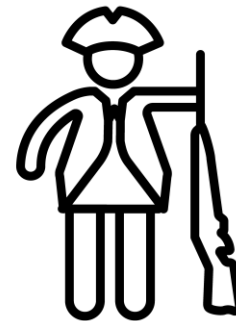
This problem started a war!

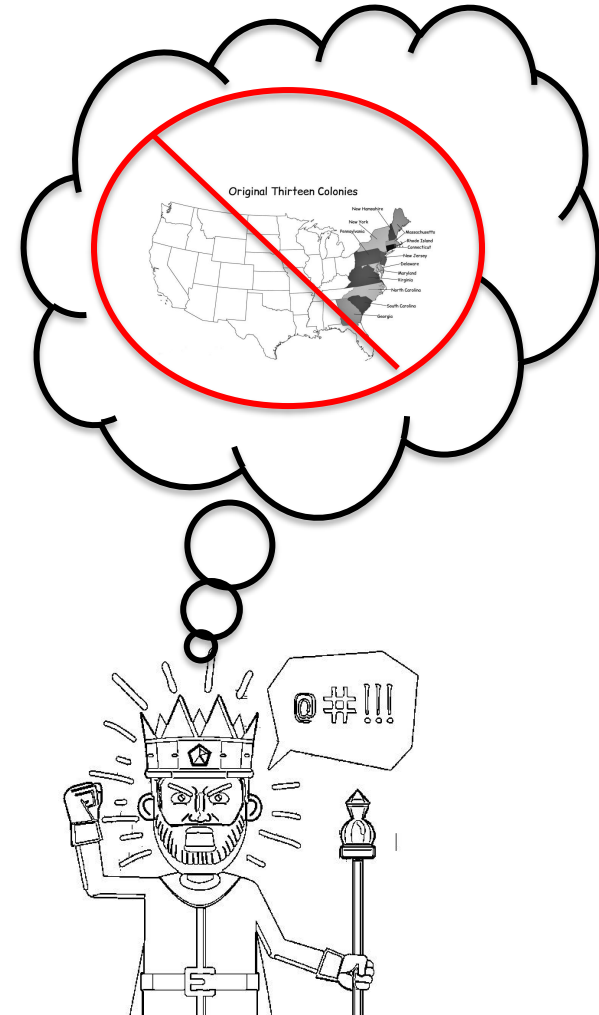


The British soldiers were called Redcoats.
