









The **Acropolis** is an <u>ancient</u> city.

The Acropolis is in **Athens**, **Greece**.



There is a wall around the Acropolis. The wall protected the ancient city from <u>enemies</u>.








The **Parthenon** is an ancient ruin in the Acropolis. It was a <u>temple</u> for the Goddess Athena.
