



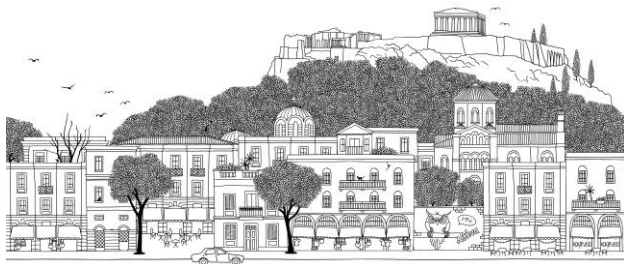

Ancient Greece Acropolis



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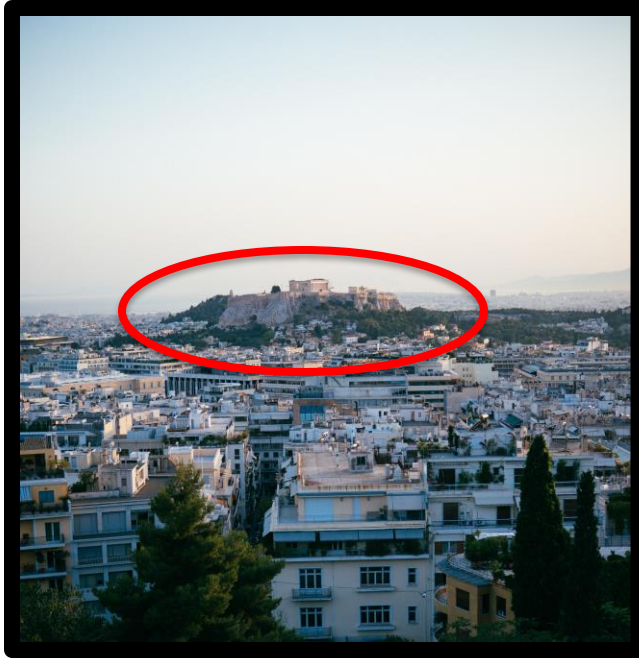
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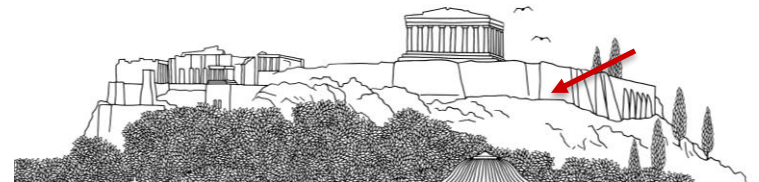
The Acropolis is an ancient city.



The Acropolis is in **Athens, Greece**.



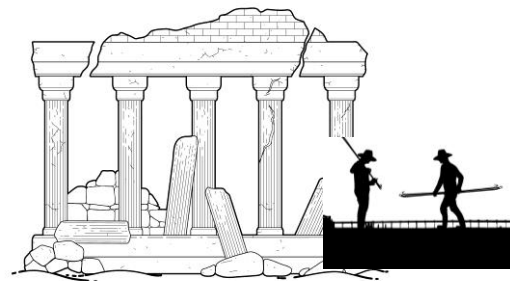
Acropolis means 'high city'.

There are ancient ruins in the Acropolis. **Ruins** are ancient buildings that need to be fixed.



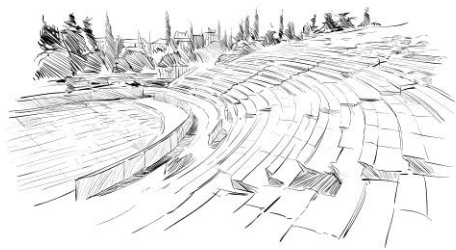
People in Greece are fixing the ancient ruins. The ruins are being **restored**.
