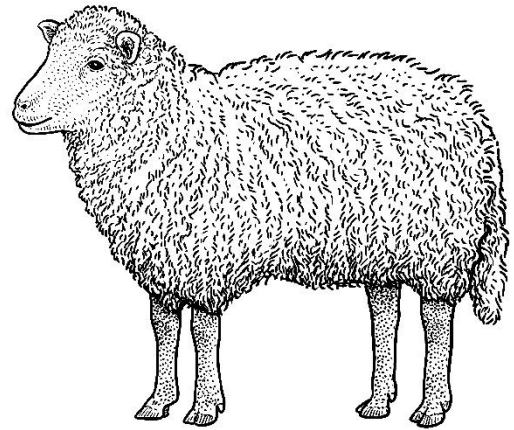
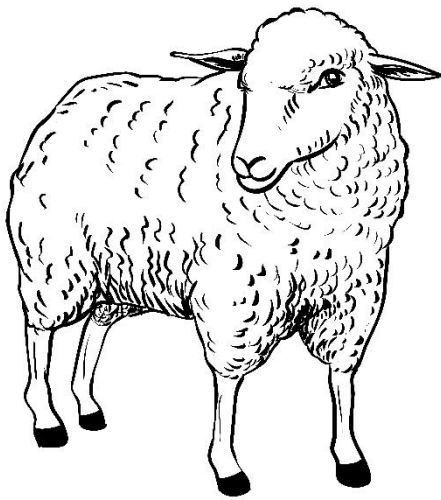


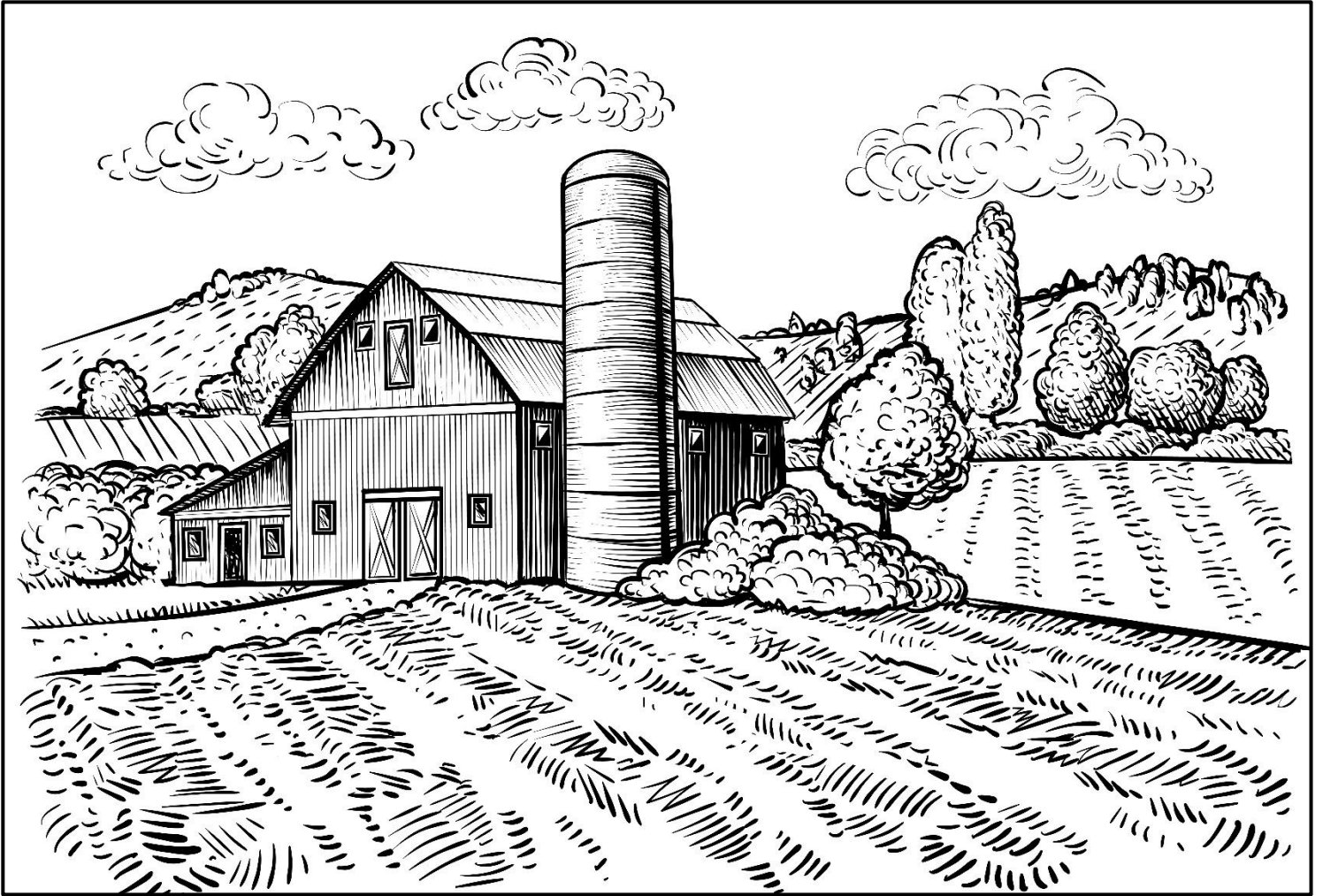

Directions: Color the water in the bucket and the hay.

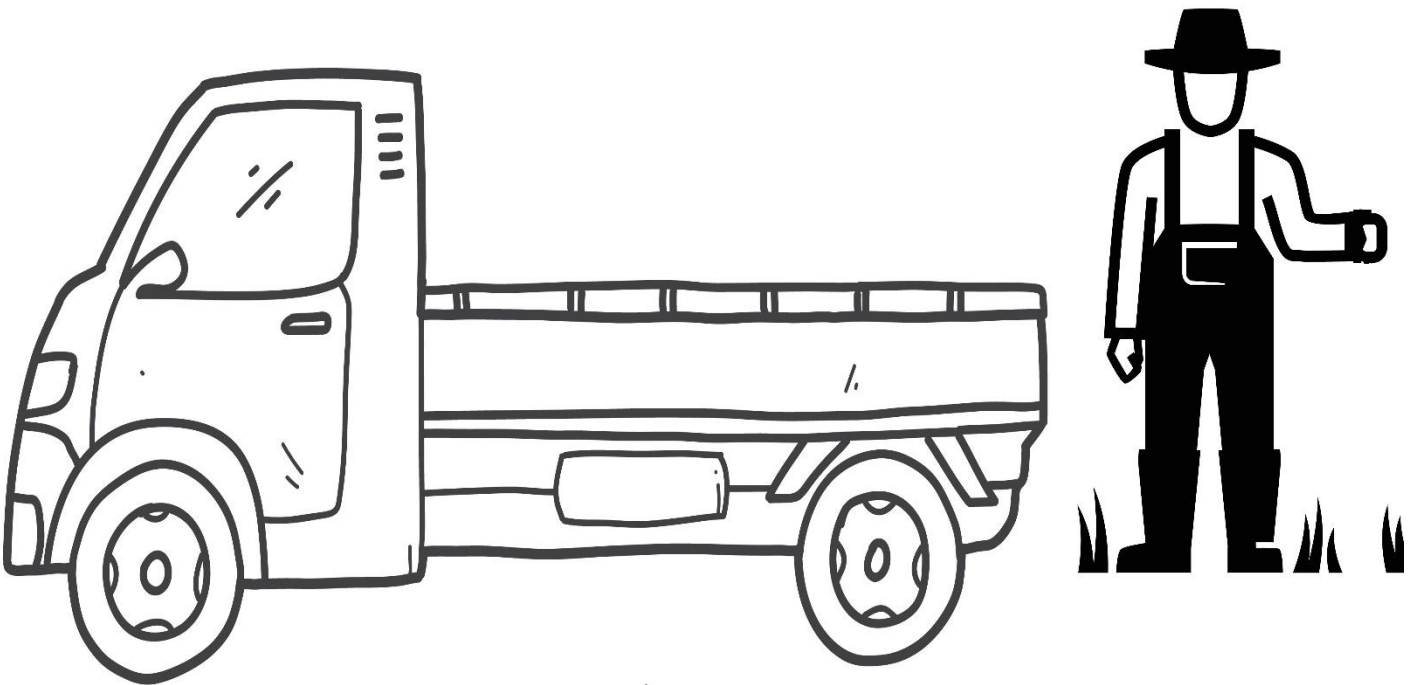


Farmers feed sheep and give them water. Sheep eat grass, corn, and hay.

2. Cut out the money. Glue the money into the farmer's hands.

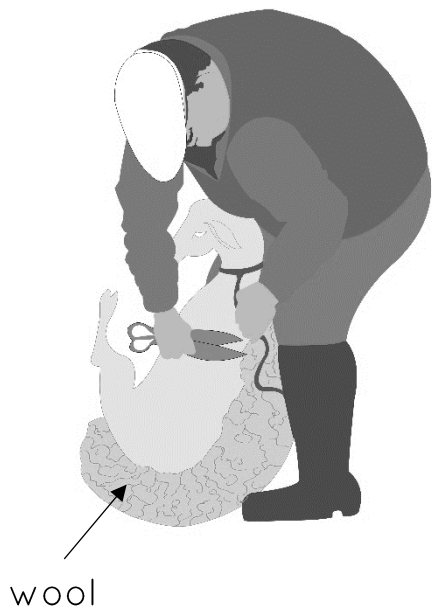


Sheep are livestock. Farmers make money from livestock.

2. Glue the wool sweater and hat on the man.

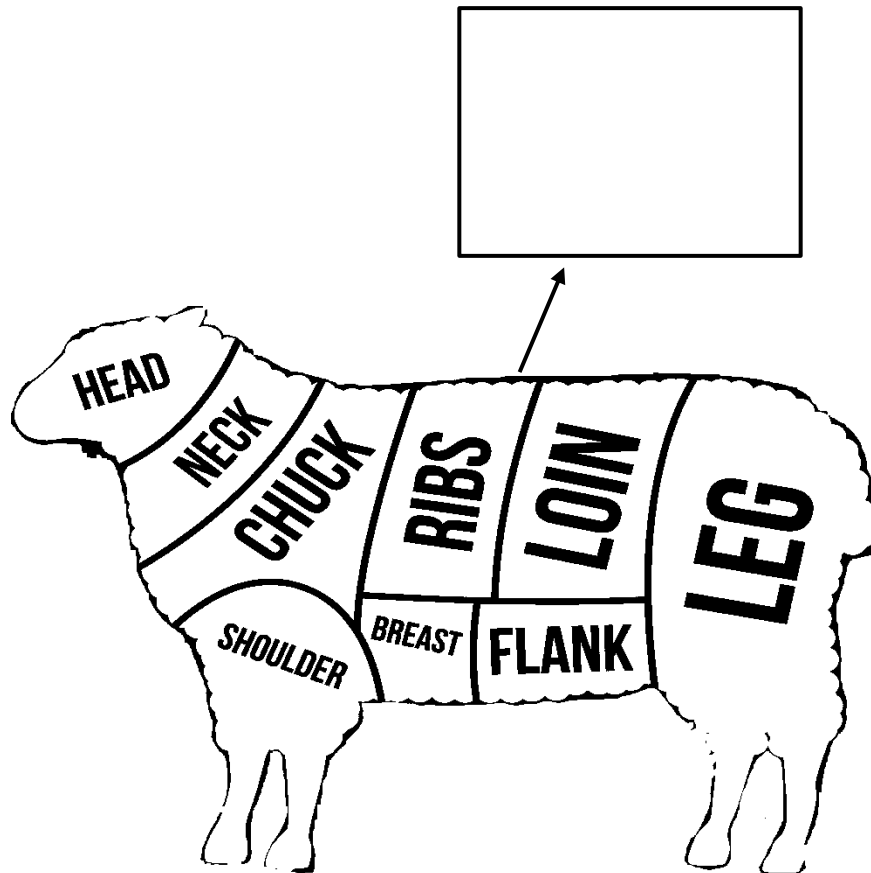


Wool is used to make yarn and clothes.

2. Glue the mutton in the box.

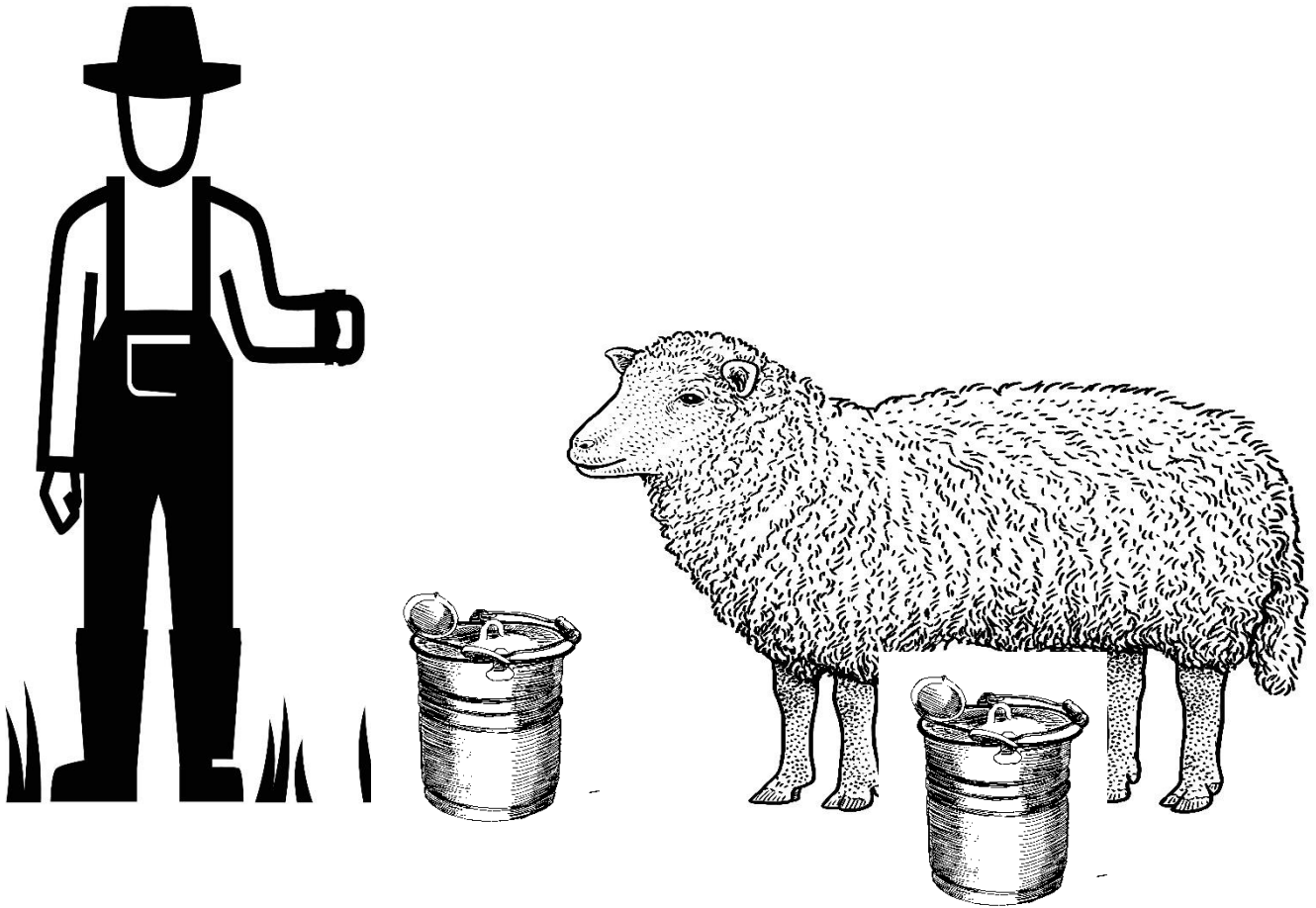


The meat from sheep is called mutton. Farmers sell mutton.

1. Cut out the money. Glue the money onto the farmer's hand.



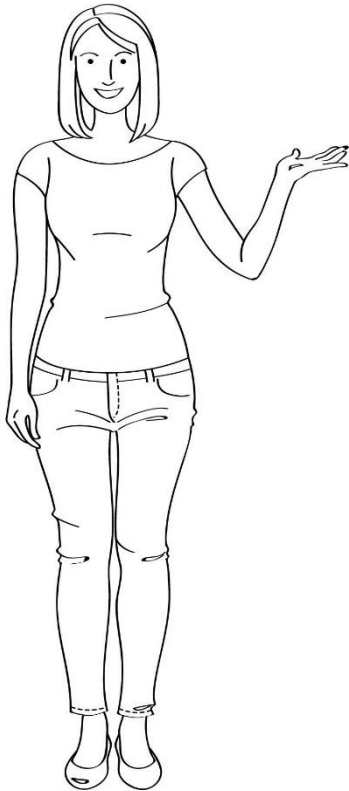
Sheep milk is used to make cheese. Farmers sell the milk.
