

Directions: Color the state you live in.




A **veteran** is someone who was in the military. Veterans are not in the military now.




Directions: Circle the United States (USA).



Veterans protected the United States.




- 1. Color the airplane.
- 2. Cut out the pilot. Glue the pilot inside the plane.




Some veterans protected the air.




- 1. Color the ship.

Some veterans protected the seas.




- 1. Color the land.
- 2. Cut out the soldier. Glue the soldier on the land.




Some veterans protected land.




Directions: Cut out the soldier. Glue the soldier outside of the fence.

Directions: Cut out the soldier. Glue the soldier near the boxes.




Some veterans protected things.

Directions: Color the veterans.









