Ideas for book-

1. Walk around your neighborhood hunting for lantana.
2. When you see one, take a picture of it.
3. Look at your lantana chart and put an 'x' on the box under the color you find.
4. At home, upload the pictures and use them to make a PowerPoint.
5. One slide for each photo. Type something about the plant. Examples

'This lantana is yellow.' Or 'yellow'
"We found 3 yellow lantana plants"
(use your chart to see how many you marked.)

Write a story about looking for lantana.

Present your PowerPoint to your family.

purple flowers.



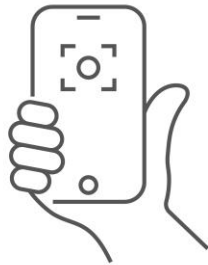
Some lantana bushes
