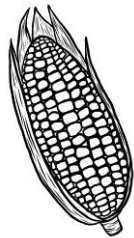

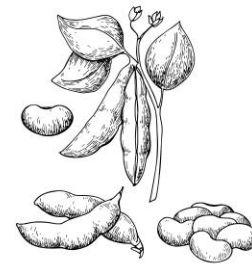
The Havasupai are American Indians. They lived in the Grand Canyon in the summer.



The Havasupai people planted seeds to grow food.



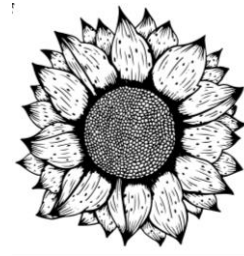
They grew corn in the Grand Canyon.
